Instructions and Checklist for Completing Scholarship Application

Building a Workforce

The Home Builders Association of Greater Kansas City (KCHBA) is a nonprofit that serves as the voice of the housing industry. Eligibility Criteria

1. The applicant must be a high school senior or equivalent and planning to enroll in an institution of higher learning (University, Community College or Vocational School) no later than September 1, 2022.
